A. Charity Announcement

D. Auto Cross additional events

Lindsey reported 27 cars attended the last autocross event. She wanted to thank Ed Milliken and Paul Rowan for their help as driving instructors and Gary Roeder for laying out the course. Lindsey proposed multiple autocross events during the year. She will form a committee to work on this. Some of the improvements she proposed were a display board to post the times and an announcer to call out the times as they are posted.

John reported that we need new timing equipment. After some investigation he presented a proposal from Race America for a package of equipment that he believes will meet our future needs. He explained a few options for equipment and spare parts. John will talk with someone from Snake River SCCA to get their opinion and recommendations.
