- Significant progress on the Club's foundational documents
 - Articles of Incorporation
 - Have been updated and filed with State of Idaho; Silver Sage is a nonprofit social club.
 - Bylaws
 - Last updated in 2015 and are available on the Constant Contact email link
 - Used the 2021 template provided by National as a guide for our Bylaws
 - Some changes include:
 - Clarify the "Badge" of the Regional Club
 - Reworked definition of honorary members
 - Updated term of elected officers to 2 years with ability to serve for 2 terms. Current officers are one year term based on 2015 Bylaws
 - Officers have no minimum quorum for votes, simple majority
 - Bylaw's change requires 10% of active members to participate with simple majority
