Treasurer Report

Gary Roeder

- Gary reviewed the 2023 finances. In 2023, the Club ran a deficit of \$1450 against budgeted deficit of \$3545.
- The 2024 Budget was discussed by the Board and members present. For 2024, the board approved a deficit budget of \$2476. Member dues/income projected to be flat at \$7400, merchandise net revenue \$500 (if PCA Webstore sales target is met) and autocross shows net revenue of \$914 if registration goals are reached. Tours and events show an overall deficit primarily due to Highway Cleanup and President's Zone 6 meeting expenses in Bend, \$1350. Membership expenses primarily for New Member Dinner and name tags show deficit of \$1350. Holiday Party planned subsidy will be \$2000. Oktoberfast, Charity Drive and Meetings are budgeted at breakeven. Sage Tick loses \$2200 for printing and design expenses, assuming a continuing level of advertising revenue. Administrative expenses run about \$4000.
