Meeting called to Order: by President Anthony Vierra at 6:34 pm.

Directors Reports:

Zone 6 President's meeting recap – Held in Sydney, BC this year. The Executive Committee(EC) for PCA National is that directing that there will be no co-hosting of events with non-PCA entities. The EC encouraging us to host events with other PCA regions. As a region, we can do events that other entities are participating in, but we as a PCA Region cannot co-advertise with them and it cannot be an event that we have planned together. Brad Pate, Zone 6 representative, will send bullet points on this topic and this information will be sent out to the membership.

Planning club events, please check to see if there is a subsidy from PCA. Important to use our annual subsidies.

PCA National has a platform now for onboarding new members. Anthony will coordinate with Lindsey, National Membership Chair, and Loren for using this platform with our membership.

National PCA membership growth for 2025 was 4-5%. Average age of PCA member is now 52 years old.

It is against PCA Bylaws for any region to charge the general public (spectators) for an event. Non-members are not permitted to drive in our club tours. For Autocross events, non PCA members drive under their SCCA membership.

There is a PCA app for the phone for a quick way to check membership. This app is ONLY available to officers based on PCA permissions. Discussion held.

June 6 Coffee and Porsches and Fast Lane Drive update: Both clubs will be meeting at Porsche Boise. Encourage members to mingle but it is not a co-hosted event. After the social time, SSPCA will head north for our drive and Fast Lane will head south for their drive.
